Corbett is generally colder than in town and it can be windy. Please bring well-fitted, work gloves and if you are riding, well-fitted, riding or bicycle helmet. We likely can loan these if needed. Due to insurance restrictions, everyone must wear <u>long pants</u> , <u>sturdy shoes and gloves</u> to work with horses and <u>helmets</u> to ride horses. A continental breakfast is provided. We do have a refrigerator and microwave available. Please bring your dinner food with you as well or there are two small café/markets within a few miles.

Keep in mind that your helmet must fit over your hair that is pulled back. The rules above regarding attire are designed to keep you or your child safe.
