**Parent Reminder for the Week (Please read, you will need this!
Please share with your other drivers also. It is important! Thanks.)**

- * We transport your child Monday afternoons through Friday mornings only!
- * Please leave your child's helmets and gloves here at the farm all week. They will need them each day.
- * Please send a healthy lunch each day with your child and a water bottle.
- * Please have child's bangs pinned back and hair in a ponytail each day, all week. **IT IS MANDATORY!** Please pin back boy's long hair as well. We do not want dirty, animal slimed hands rubbing hair out of eyes all day. Plus, they need to see really well for working with animals and especially, large and unpredictable 1,000 pound horses and cow.
- * Please have students bring a water bottle each day or just leave it for the week.
- * Please lube up with generous amounts of sunscreen daily; we cannot oversee this nor dispense it.
- * Please wear long pants. Shorts or Capri pants are not allowed.
- * Please meet us here at the farm at 2:55 for pick up if you are driving your child Mon-Thur afternoons.
- * Please meet The Bus for Old McDonald's Farm, Inc. (OMF) at Concorde Career College, 1425 NE Irving St, Portland OR 97232. You can enter on NE 15th/Irving or NE 16th/Irving where it is paved. Head north under the building and then turn right. Head east to the back of the property away from all of those buildings. Look for our bus and the really, really, big, old Crimson tree. Concorde Career College has kindly offered this drop off/pick up space to us but please be respectful and do not linger there because we do not want to take up their student parking. They have asked us to drive slowly and watch out for the young people "racing in there" that are late for classes. Please drive super slowly and be careful as it is tight and there are many pedestrians. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE DOWN THE GRAVEL ROAD AT CONCORDE COLLEGE. There is no access for parents on the gravel road even though our OMF bus will drive on it. If parents drive on the gravel road, we may lose this parking privilege at Concorde. (The bus is too tall to fit under the buildings.)

Please join us Fridays for the student's presentations to the parents. Friends and family are welcome. No pets please.

For the six weeks of the Summer Programs (week of the Dog, Pig, Goat, Sheep, Pony and Cow) presentations are from 2:00 sharp to 3:30 on Fridays.

For Jr. Vet. Ruminant Program, Jr. Vet. Equine Program and Horses of the World Program, on Fridays the presentations are from 12 noon straight up to 1:30.

Bus times are 7:50 and 3:30 for the Summer Programs-the week of the Dog, Pig, Goat, Sheep, Pony and Cow and both Jr. Vet's. and Horses of the World.

- * We do not transport children on Friday afternoons or ever on Monday mornings.
- * Please join us this Friday at 2:00 sharp for the kid's presentations for the Summer Programs. Please do not be late; the kids have worked on what they are going to share with you all week. We will be done at 3:30ish. Friends and family are all welcome but no pets please.
- * Please join us at 12 noon for kids' presentations for the Jr. Vet. Ruminant, Jr. Vet. Equine and Horses of the World program. Please do not be late.

*****Please do not wear sandals or flip-flops on Friday afternoons. Please ask your guests to not wear open-toed shoes. OPEN-TOED SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED BY OUR INSURANCE COMPANY. You will be around heavy horses, cows, etc. plus you will encounter dirt and manure.
